Cancer Services -Little Red Door continues to recognize the important role that education plays in the prevention and early detection of cancer. Educational materials have been distributed at several health fairs in the community and presentations have been made to various organizations. The following education programs are provided upon request: **Smoke Free Heroes**, an elementary school tobacco prevention program, incorporating the Centers for Disease Control's (CDC) instructional concepts. Through interactive activities students learn the dangers of tobacco and refusal skills to help them remain tobacco free. **BSE and TSE for Teens** are programs that are designed to help high schools meet state requirements. This year, nearly 600 high school students in 6 schools learned life-saving early detection techniques for breast and testicular cancer. **"Reaching Out" Breast Health Program** in its fifth year once again is funded by the Avon Foundation Breast Care Fund, Susan G. Komen for the Cure, Indianapolis Affiliate and the Indiana Breast Cancer Awareness Trust. This community partnership is committed to ensuring that no woman in Delaware County goes without breast health services. To-date 1,200 uninsured and underinsured women have been reached with vital breast health education and free screenings. The **Prostate Cancer Support Group** meets monthly to provide education and support to men with prostate cancer and their families. New and long term members comment on the benefit of the group in terms of allaying fears and learning new information. CSDC-Little Red Door continues to take an active role in the **Tobacco Free Coalition of Delaware County**. The agency shares in the vision of the coalition to promote a healthy, tobacco-free lifestyle. To that end, the agency provides individual and group tobacco cessation counseling and participates in other coalition activities. Our **Client Services Program** helps to ensure that individuals and families dealing with a cancer diagnosis receive the equipment, supplies and support needed to maintain the highest quality of life possible during their experience. The **Cancer Assistance Program (CAP)** is an increasingly vital service, helping to reduce the financial burden of a cancer diagnosis. The program assists uninsured clients with cancer-related medications and/or cancer determination procedures. Transportation assistance is provided in the form of gas vouchers, gas cards or public transportation so that clients can receive scheduled treatments. Our **Equipment Loan and Supply Program** promotes comfort and facilitates home care of our clients. A variety of equipment, linens and comfort items are available, as well as a selection of wigs and turbans. Mastectomy supplies are available for uninsured and underinsured clients.
