### "Reaching Out" Breast Health Program

2009 marked the seventh year that Cancer Services of ECI Little Red Door has administered the "Reaching Out" Breast Health Program, with the commitment of ensuring that no woman in Delaware County goes without access to vital breast health services. We have been able to provide this program in the community thanks to major funders and our collaboration with area medical providers and community partners.

A \$28,000 grant from the **Avon Foundation Breast Care Fund** is made possible with a gift from the Avon Foundation, an accredited 501 (c) 3 public charity with a long commitment to access to care and finding a cure for breast cancer. These funds allowed us to reach over 700 women with breast health education through community programs and at our agency. The grant also made possible a variety of methods to ensure that medically underserved participants are able to access necessary breast health services. These included transportation and child care assistance and incentives to keep appointments.

**The Indiana Breast Cancer Awareness Trusts'**

mission is to raise awareness and improve breast cancer screening and diagnosis throughout Indiana. Funds are raised through the sale of the Breast Cancer Awareness license plate. Our agency received a \$9,900 grant which allowed us to facilitate screening mammograms for 88 uninsured women.

**The Indianapolis Affiliate of Susan G. Komen for the Cure** operates with the promise to save lives and end breast cancer forever by empowering people, ensuring quality care for all and energizing science to find the cures. A \$59,350 grant from Komen Indy allowed us to provide services such as breast exams, mammograms, ultrasounds and surgical consultations for nearly 200 uninsured women. Komen Indy funds also allowed us to provide client navigation, ensuring that participants received recommended screening, diagnostic and follow up services.

We were able to work in collaboration with the Indiana Breast & Cervical Cancer Program to assist more than 100 additional women who qualified for services at no charge to them.

Administered by the **BMH Foundation, the Breast Center Fund**, formerly called the Yes Mamm Foundation, began in 1992 by the Muncie Quilters Guild. The fund continues to pay for mammograms for uninsured women. "Reaching Out" is permitted to access these funds for program participants when grant funds are depleted.

In addition to our grantors, "Reaching Out" could not happen without the generous support of our medical providers, **BMH Breast Center at The Imaging Center, BMH Family Medicine Residency Program, Open Door Health Services & Muncie Surgical Associates**, all of which offer our program free or discounted services, allowing us to stretch our grant funds.

"Reaching Out" is a true collaborative effort. In addition to our medical providers, the agency partners with **The Cancer Center at BMH & the Delaware County Health Coalition** to provide education & remove barriers to access for women seeking breast health services.

Our Client Advocate works one-on-one with our clients and caregivers, ensuring that they have the necessary knowledge and resources needed to get care. In 2009, we helped 18 clients with getting on Medicaid, Medicare and HIP services. The agency was able to recover \$1,986.12 in funds spent through the Client Assistance Program.
